About the Koola Kampala Incubation Programme

Who:

Ugandan cultural and creative entrepreneurs

Legally registered cultural or creative businesses based in Kampala

What:

A programme offering structured business support, mentorship, and skills development

A partnership between **Africalia** and **The Bold Woman Fund** (an initiative by **Bold in Africa**)

When:

July 2025 - May 2026

Where:

Kampala, Uganda

How:

Delivered through workshops, one-on-one mentorship, tailored business development sessions, networking opportunities, showcase events, and seed funding.

Why:

To empower Uganda's next generation of cultural entrepreneurs

Aligned with the 2005 UNESCO Convention, the Sustainable Development Goals, and national cultural policies

Eligibility Criteria

A legally registered cultural or creative businesses (e.g. fashion, music, dance, film, photography, art, crafts, cultural tourism, storytelling)

Running for at least one year

Based in Kampala

Above the age of **18**

Available to attend all programme workshops (some may run up to 5 consecutive days) or be able to send a committed representative in their place.

Have **samples** available upon request

Already **generating revenue** (not solely grant-dependent)

New: Applications now **open to men** too.

Note: TBWF programme alumni are not eligible to apply due to the overlap with existing or previous support

Programme Structure (12 months)

1. Selection Phase

15 - 20 cultural and creative businesses will be shortlisted based on eligibility and programme fit.

2. Pre-Incubation Phase - 3 Months

- Diagnostic assessment of their businesses
- Tailored group and individual coaching
- Training on business fundamentals

At the end of this phase, **only 12 finalists** will be selected to move forward into the main incubation programme.

3. Incubation Phase - 9 Months

- Group training and weekly one-on-one coaching
- Seed funding (1,500 Euros/approx. 6.3m Ugx)
- Support in implementing business growth strategies
- Specialised modules
- Additional sessions based on participant needs

4. Post-Incubation Phase

Tailored action plans for each business

- Expert-led business training
- Tailored mentorship
- Real market access opportunities
- Potential funding support (1,500 Euros/approx. 6.3million Ugx)
- Peer learning + alumni network
